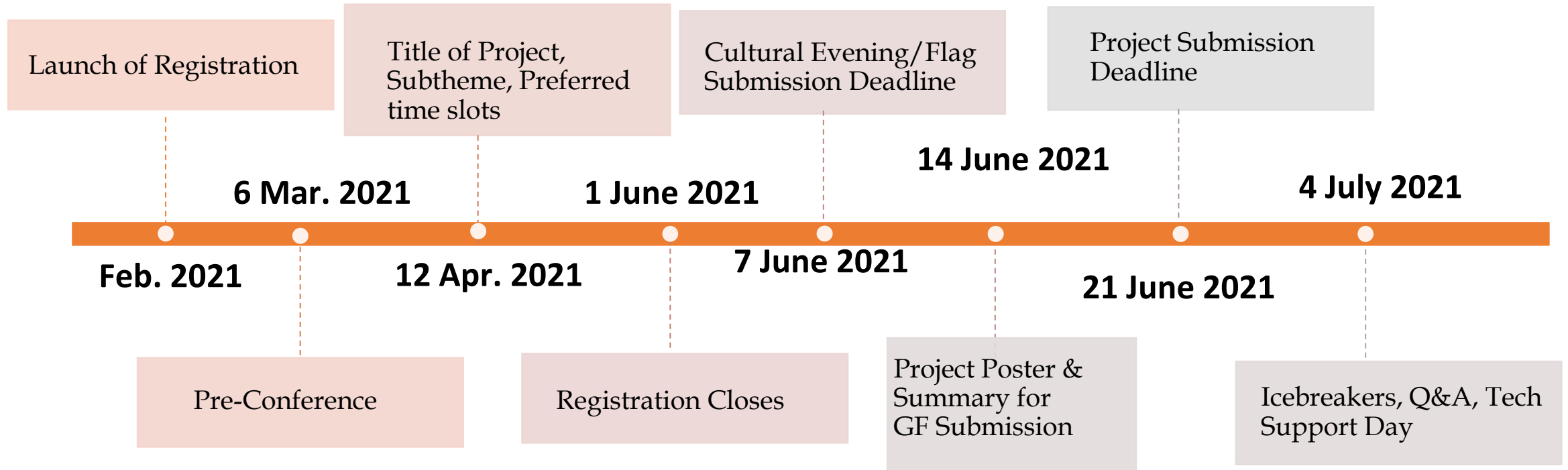

# Important Information for Teachers

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Similar to in 2020:

- Virtual Conference - Free of cost!
- You can register as many students as you like, e.g. you can have 3 groups of students presenting 3 different projects
- You do not have to attend every session, students can attend on their own if you have teaching responsibilities, however their behaviour is your responsibility
- There will be a participant statement for you to review when registering. We advise you provide your students with the link to this so they and their parents/guardians can read it before the conference too



# Important Information for Teachers

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New for 2021:

- To try and accommodate timezones (as best as possible), for project presentations & workshops, there will be **multiple timeslots available** for your delegation. We will ask in advance which timeslot suits best, however you must be online and available at your chosen timeslot, changes can not be made last minute.
- There will be a morning session (9-13 GMT) or an afternoon session (15-18 GMT) to choose from. In addition, **there is a central session from 13.00-15.00 GMT which must be attended by all participants.**
- In order to receive a certificate, students must attend the central session each day, along with one project session and at least one workshop session.

# Projects

- Project presentations must be **pre-recorded** and this recording must be submitted by the project deadline. The format in which you choose to present your project is up to you, e.g. a short film, a play, a recording of the students presenting slides. These recordings must be a **maximum of 10 minutes**.
- You and your students must be present for the project presentation slot in which your pre-recorded presentation will be in as after it is shown, there will be a **10 minute Q&A session** where fellow participants can ask questions about your project.
- We will give you a choice of 3 timeslots for the project presentations in advance to choose from.
- Students must also:
  1. Write a **project summary for Global Forum** (200-250 words & 2-3 photos) which should be submitted by 14 June
  2. Create a **poster** about their project, which will be posted as a virtual poster exhibition on the CEI Alumni website in advance of the conference. An outline of the format for this can be found on the website in the Project Presentations part of the Forum

# Flag Ceremony

- This year, we want to encourage creativity in the students.
- We would like them to create their flag themselves in a fun way, e.g. out of cake, out of trash they find, paint it, etc.
- The CEI Alumni will provide an example in the coming weeks on their Social Media so keep an eye out!
- Each delegation must submit a video of maximum 2 minutes of how they made their flag and showing the finished flag.
- These will be compiled and shown at the opening ceremony.
